### Welcoming Committee

Welcome new residents to the community by inviting them to meals, social events and introducing them to their neighbors (*This opportunity is open only to residents*).

### Liturgical Ministers

#### Eucharistic Ministers

Assist the Presider at our Liturgies with the setting up of the Altar and with the distribution of Holy Communion during the Celebration of the Eucharist (*must be a practicing catholic*).

#### Lectors

Proclaim the Word of God during our Liturgical Celebrations at St. Joseph's Chapel.

#### Ushers

Guide residents to open seats and assist them with parking their walkers or other mobility assisting devices during various celebrations at our Chapel.
